



Toddlers enjoy fun and exploration in the MIR Summer Program

The MIR Toddler Summer Program provides continuity in your child's education and consistency in their environment while providing plenty of summer fun.

Toddlers (ages 18 months to 2 1/2 years) will supplement their Montessori environment with special summer activities including gardening, crafts, and water play. An outing to the San Bernardino County Museum will enhance their summer enjoyment.

WHO CAN ENROLL

The summer program is open to continuing Toddler students and new students enrolled for the 2012-2013 school year.

WHEN AND HOW TO ENROLL

Registration for current MIR families begins April 2. The deposit for families who register before April 30 is \$100. All families who register after April 30 will be required to pay the full amount of the first session attending at the time of registration.

New families may register starting May 1 and will be required to pay the full amount of the first session attending.

Deposits are non-refundable and apply toward summer school fees only.

To enroll, complete all registration forms and bring them to the office along with your required deposit. Enrollment is



first-come, first-served. The last days to make changes are as follows: Session 1 – May 25; Session 2 – June 15; Session 3 – June 29; and Session 4 – July 13.

LUNCHES

Please bring a nutritious lunch for your child everyday. Beverages are provided by the school.

CHILDCARE

Childcare is available 7:15-9 AM to all students, and 5–6 PM for all students with the exception of two-day Toddler students. Drop-in childcare before and after class requires 24-hour notice, space permitting. The drop-in childcare rate is:

- With 24hr. notice: \$9.50 per hour (1 hour min.)
- With less than 24hr. notice: \$14.50 per hour (1 hour min.)

There is no school and no childcare on July 4 and August 13-24. The 2012-2013 school year begins August 27.
